

Curbside Recycling Service

Participating residential or commercial customers will choose between receiving a 65-gallon roll cart or two 18-gallon bins. A monthly \$3 fee will be added to the town utility bill of those participating to cover collection costs.

The town will collect plastic bottles, jars and jugs (marked #1 and #2), aluminum cans, steel cans, paper, newspaper, magazines and cardboard. Items should be bagged in clear plastic bags and may be mixed together. Participants will receive 25 bags upon registering and additional bags may be purchased at Town Hall at a cost of \$5 per 25 bags. Participants may also purchase clear bags from retailers.

The town will service recycling containers on the first and third Wednesdays of each month. Carts or bins should be placed at the curb by 7 AM and removed by Noon on the following day.

To begin service, residents and businesses should call (623-2131) or come by Town Hall. A one-year agreement will need to be signed to begin service. The agreement may be voided early if you close your Town utility account.

Businesses may want to examine their waste collection needs and consider signing up for multiple recycling carts in exchange for smaller dumpsters at a reduced cost.
